Arrival

Students arriving after 8:20 a.m. **must** report to the school office for a tardy slip/hall pass and **be accompanied by a parent**. Morning announcements begin promptly at 8:20 a.m. **Preschool Circle Time** begins promptly at 8:25 a.m. following the morning announcements.
