## The Management of Covid-19



Suspected case of COVID-19

Person is sent to the clinic for assessment, and home if warranted.

Notify physician. COVID-19 testing or quarantine may be required to return to campus.

Household members must self-isolate as well.

Person does

not take a

COVID-19 test.

Person may be out

of school for 10

days from the

beginning of

symptoms and

must be symptom

free for 72 hours

without the use of

medications, before

returning to school.

Person takes a COVID-19 test.

If person tests
(-) for
COVID-19,
they may
return to
school when
symptom free
for 48 hours
without the
use of
medications.

If person tests positive for COVID-19, follow confirmed case protocol. Known exposure to COVID-19

Anyone that has been in close contact with someone with COVID-19

Unvaccinated person

Vaccinated person

Person takes a COVID-19 test no earlier than 5 days from exposure

If COVID-19
test results are
negative and
person remains
asymptomatic,
they may
return 8 days
after last
contact with
exposure

If person tests positive for COVID-19, follow confirmed case protocol. Confirmed cases of COVID-19

Person and household members must self isolate for 10 days

Symptomatic

Asymptomatic

Person may return to campus when:
- At least 10 days have passed since the beginning of symptoms, and
- After 48 hours have passed of being fever-free without the use of fever-reducing medications and any respiratory symptoms resolve.

Person may return to campus after 10 days have passed since taking the COVID-19 test.

Quarantine not required.
Take PCR test 5 days
after exposure and
monitor symptoms daily.
Wear a mask indoors
until test results are
received.

## **School Response**

The Unity School Clinic should be notified of suspected cases, known exposures, and confirmed cases of COVID-19. Unity School Administration and health professionals will work with the Department of Health to undertake an assessment through contact tracing to determine any potential exposure.
