

I thought it was funny when Arthur accidentally took D.W.'s backpack. You have to read the book to find out what happens after.




Title: Ride, Fly Guy, Ride! Author: Tedd Arnold

If you love adventure books, you will love this one. Buzz goes everywhere to catch Fly Guy.




Title: A Dollar for Penny Author: Dr. Julie Glass

In the book, the main character is kind because she sells lemonade for only one cent! -




Title: The Carrot Seed

Title: May I Please Have a Cookie Author: Jennifer E. Morris


This book reminds you that it is important to always ask before taking something that you want.

I like it so much because it teaches you to be safe!




