Super Soccer Stars (Thursdays)

It is the #1 rated children's soccer program. We aim to impact every child positively through the game of soccer. We use character words such as respect, teamwork, and determination to teach kids life skills as they learn their soccer skills. Little Chefs (Cooking Class) (Tuesdays)
